Rules for Internal Examinations

- 1. Examinations will begin at the time stated on the timetable. There will be no rescheduling of examinations.
- 2. All students should be seated in the examination room 10 minutes before the start of the examination.
- 3. Students will not be allowed in the examination room up to 30 minutes after the start of the examination process. The invigilator will make a notation of the student's name and their time of arrival.
- 4. All students should remain in their classrooms for the duration of the examination.
- 5. However, if a student disrupts the exam, his/ her paper will be confiscated and he/ she will be escorted out of the examination room.
- 6. If a student misses an examination he/she will be given a ZERO unless he/ she provides valid reasons justifying his/her absence, as in the case of a submission of a medical certificate. This evidence should be submitted to the Examination Coordinator.
- 7. Students should respect and obey the invigilators at all times.
- 8. If a student cheats on the examinations, the evidence of cheating should be confiscated by the invigilator or a general report will suffice if the evidence is not physical. After a review is done the student will be awarded a Zero (0) for that exam if there are improprieties.
- 9. If a student is caught using a cellphone, or if it rings or vibrates during an exam, he /she will not be allowed to continue the exam.
- 10. There should be no borrowing or lending of equipment during the examination.
- 11. Any correspondence during the examination process needs to be between candidate and the invigilator.
- 12. Students should be appropriately attired for their examinations.
- 13. All school rules should be adhered to during the examination period.
